BID 2017-12 Roof Replacement for Historic Courthouse.

The following information amends BID # 2017-12. All responders shall include and incorporate the following changes into their bid response.

- 1. QUESTION: The plan drawing provided in the bid document states: "Existing roof to remain" and "Existing roof below to remain". Is this correct, or do you want to entire roof replaced as the specifications state?
 - COUNTY ANSWER: The notes on the drawing stating "Existing roof to remain" and "Existing roof below to remain" should be deleted. The County wants to entire roof replaced as the specifications state.
- 2. QUESTION: On the Bid Price Sheet beneath the words "Bid Price in Words", you're asking for a "Unit Cost" to remove and replace any rotten roof decking and to remove and replace any gutter & downspout. Please define what a "unit" is.
 - COUNTY ANSWER: Decking Provide a unit price <u>per 4' x 8' sheet</u>. Gutter and Downspout – Provide a unit price per linear foot.
- 3. QUESTION: Has the Baker County Historical Society made any comments about the roofing material or provided any additional directions?
 - COUNTY ANSWER: No. We haven't received any additional comments or direction from the Historical Society.
- 4. QUESTION: Will the County do a core sample on the flat roofs so contractors can see how many layers are underneath?
 - COUNTY ANSWER: No. The County estimates two layers are currently on the flat roof. Contractors may offer the County a price for removing 1 layer, and a separate price for removing 2 layers.
- 5. QUESTION: Does the County have any color photos of the existing roof?

COUNTY ANSWER: No, we have no photos.
