

# TRUCK DRIVER

## MAJOR FUNCTIONS

This is semi skilled work in the operation of vehicles and other maintenance equipment. An employee in a position allocated to this class performs a variety of functions related to the operation of maintenance equipment. Work generally follows standardized procedures but involves choice of action within clearly defined limits.

## ILLUSTRATIVE DUTIES

**\*\*\*Note: These examples are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed for this classification. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related or a logical assignment to the position.**

Drive a truck, load and unload materials.

May perform minor repairs/adjustments or maintenance on equipment.

May operate a cement saw and performs other semi skilled tasks requiring the use of hand tools.

May operate a front end loader in loading materials.

Perform other jobs that are similarly related as directed by the supervisor.

Lift up to 50 lbs often.

Occasionally lift over 50 lbs.

## EQUIPMENT USED

Roll off trucks, front end loader, hand tools, chainsaws, tractors and mowers.

**KNOWLEDGE, ABILITY AND SKILLS:** This job entails continuous standing, walking or difficult working positions. Working with average or heavy weight materials and supplies. Fast manipulative skill in frequent use of machines and equipment.

Occasional strenuous physical activities such as climbing, walking or carrying heavy and/or awkward material or equipment.

Must have a valid FL CDL license-Class B.
