

**ADDENDUM #1**  
to Bid Documents For:  
**Madison Street-Drive Resurfacing**  
**Project #2019-05**  
Baker County, Florida  
August 23, 2019

This addendum shall be considered part of the plans, specifications and contract documents and is issued to change, add or delete from or otherwise explain the documents further. This addendum shall have precedence over the original documents and shall govern.

I. Responses to questions by contractors:

Question 1: What type of base will be used for the unpaved side streets such as Morningside Lane (STA. 19+90), Westside Street (STA. 27+25), Westside Loop (STA. 33+10) and what pay item will they be paid for under?

Response 1: All side street base construction (Walter Davis Lane, Morningside Lane, Westside Street, and both intersections with Westside Loop) and the Madison Street base construction from Sta 103+15 to 104+15 shall be in accordance with New Pavement Section A-A on sheet C0.40. Quantities shall be accounted for in pay items 160-4 and 285-704.

Note, the County may elect to perform the base work depending on the total bid costs and the County's budget.

Question 2: What type of base will be used for the unpaved residential driveways?

Response 2: Unpaved residential driveways base shall be in accordance with FDOT Index No. 515 with Type 1 Optional Base Group, 4" limerock.

Question 3: Does pay item 285-704 Optional Base Group 4 (6" Limerock) only included the base at the New Pavement Section on page C0.40 & C1.10 at station 102+68 to 104+31.13?

Response 3: No. The New Pavement Section on sheet C0.40 is for all side street base work and is accounted for in pay item 285-704 (see Response 1 above)

Question 4: Is there any CAD files available for this project?

Response 4: No, the cad files are not available during the bid phase.

Question 5: After reviewing the bidding documents, the “Florida Trench Safety Act Certification” and the “Drug Free Workplace Certification” forms are not included in the documents, but are required.

Response 5: See Attachment 1 for Florida Trench Safety Act Certification and Drug Free Workplace Certifications forms to be included with Contractor’s bid.

Question 6: Where do you want the pricing for the sidewalk demo and replacement to be put according to the bid form?

Response 6: Demolition shall be included in pay item 110-1-1 Clearing and Grubbing. Sidewalk construction shall be included in pay item 522-1 Concrete Sidewalk and Driveways, 4”. Detectable Warnings shall be included in pay item 527-2. See Attachment 2 for updated Bid Tab Form.
