NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals will be received until 4:00 PM, Thursday, December 2, 2021, at the Baker County Administration Building, 55 N 3rd St, Macclenny, FL 32063, for the following:

Bid No. 2021-19 STORM WATER DRAINAGE PIPE

Bids will be opened at 4:00 PM, or as soon thereafter as possible, on Thursday, December 2, 2021, in the Baker County Administration Building, 55 N 3rd St, Macclenny, FL 32063, in the presence of the County Staff and all other interested persons. The opened bids will be read aloud.

Bids will not be valid unless received by the proposal deadline and in a sealed envelope marked: "**Bid No. 2021-19, STORM WATER DRAINAGE PIPE**". Envelopes are to be submitted in person or delivered by courier to the above address. No postal mail will be accepted.

BID #2021-19, STORM WATER DRAINAGE PIPE SCOPE OF SERVICES

(As provide by Public Works Department)

1. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- a) The intent of these specifications is to provide a basis for furnishing all materials to be delivered FOB to 9500 CR 125 S, Glen St Mary, FL 32040. Florida Department of Transportation Approved Double or Triple Walled High Density Polyethylene Pipe and High-Performance Polypropylene Storm Water Pipe, and accessories as defined on the attached bid price sheet.
- b) No quantities are guaranteed from this solicitation. The estimated quantities set forth in the pricing tables are the expected quantity to be ordered. Only one type of pipe is expected to be purchased for this project, either the HDPE or the polypropylene.
- c) The County reserves the right to make changes, substitutions, additions, or subtractions to the bid as necessary to best serve the needs of the County and its Citizens.
- d) All delivery will be performed during normal County business hours (7:00am to 5:00pm) on non-holiday weekdays, unless otherwise authorized by the Project Manager. Any delivery performed outside of normal County business hours will require prior County approvals and payment to the County for all expense incurred by the County for overtime costs in accordance with the Baker County pay scale.
- e) **There will be no fuel or transportation surcharges added to any invoice other than the line item for delivery charge as bid. Prices quoted shall be final cost to Baker County.**
- f) Unit prices as received will constitute full payment to the Vendor for all associated activities necessary for the delivery of purchase materials. No separate payments will be made for any activities, traffic control, or mobilizations outside of the scope of these specifications.
- g) All invoices shall contain the purchase order number, date and location of delivery and service, and confirmation of acceptance of the goods or services by the appropriate County representative. Failure to submit invoices in the prescribed manner will delay payment, and the Vendor may be considered in default.
- h) The bid prices resultant from this solicitation shall prevail for the full duration of the initial bid term of three (3) months. Prior to, or upon completion, of the initial term of this Bid, the

County shall have the option to purchase additional pipe if both parties agree for an additional one year.

- i) If the Vendor cannot provide products/services, Baker County reserves the right to seek out and purchase these materials from other County approved Vendors.
- j) The Vendor must furnish the following warranty:
 - a. The Vendor hereby warrants that all materials furnished under this bid comply fully with requirements of the specifications. If at any time within one (1) year after the date of the submission of the final inspection and payment, any unfaithful or defective material should appear which in the opinion of the County is due to inferior materials, the Vendor warrants taking all necessary actions to remedy the defects immediately at no cost to the County. The County will notify the Vendor in writing of the defects and the repairs to be made, and the Vendor will begin repair/replacement at a mutually agreed period.
 - b. The warranty period shall become effective on the date the final payment is approved, signed, and submitted by the authorized Baker County representative.
 - c. The County reserves the right to reject any material that appears to be defective or damaged at the time of delivery or pick-up.
- k) All material shall meet all requirements of the January 2019 Florida Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for the Road and Bridge Construction unless otherwise specified by the County.
