

Appendix – Engineer Report and Cost Estimate (Scope of Work)

The Contractor shall perform the work as detailed in the attached Appendix Engineer's Report, which outlines the necessary tasks to be completed. This work is funded in whole or in part by FEMA Public Assistance funds, and all responses to this RFP must demonstrate a comprehensive understanding of the scope and the associated documentation requirements. In particular, proposals must address the following critical elements:

1. Hydrologic and Hydraulic (H&H) Study Requirements:

Proposals shall detail the methodology and tools to be utilized for conducting any required hydrologic and hydraulic studies. This includes data collection, analysis, and modeling efforts necessary to evaluate flood risks and water management implications associated with the project.

2. Environmental and Historic Preservation (EHP) Considerations:

Respondents must describe their approach to ensuring compliance with all applicable environmental and historic preservation requirements. This section should include an assessment of potential environmental impacts, identification of any historic preservation issues, and the implementation of appropriate mitigation measures in accordance with federal, state, and local guidelines.

3. Permitting:

Proposals must include a comprehensive plan for obtaining all required permits prior to commencing work. This plan should identify the anticipated permits, outline the permitting process, and provide estimated timelines and potential challenges associated with securing the necessary approvals.

4. Debris Disposal Requirements:

Respondents are required to provide a detailed debris management plan that complies with all federal, state, and local regulations. This plan must outline procedures for the safe and environmentally responsible disposal of debris generated by the project.

All proposals must include supporting documentation and certifications that verify the Contractor's understanding of and ability to comply with these requirements. The Contractor shall coordinate with local authorities, environmental agencies, and other stakeholders to ensure that all work is executed in a timely, cost-effective, and compliant manner. Failure to address any of these components in the proposal may result in disqualification.

By submitting a proposal, the Contractor acknowledges and agrees to perform the work in strict adherence to the scope, guidelines, and requirements as set forth in this Section and the attached Appendix Engineer's Report.
