### INVITATION TO BID

The Baker County Board of County Commissioners is seeking sealed bids from qualified General Contractors to extend one vehicle bay at Fire Station 20. The work involves extending the far right bay approximately 12' x 16' to accommodate a longer fire truck, and includes walls, framing, roof, electrical, and other materials that match the existing structure to make the new extension look part of the original construction. The successful contractor must develop a plan/design for the project that is stamped by an engineer registered with the State of Florida. The County is seeking a lump sum price that includes construction, plans, design, permits, etc for a turn-key project. Estimated cost of project \$15,000 - \$20,000.

**MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE will be held on September 28, 2017 at, 9:00 a.m. local time. Bidders are required to attend to be eligible to bid on the project. This project requires Performance and Payments Bonds to be provided.**

Bid will be received until 3:00 p.m., October 12, 2017 in the Office of the County Manager, Baker County Board of Commissioners, 55 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Macclenny FL 32063. **Bid MUST have the respondent's name and mailing address clearly shown on the outside of the envelope or package when submitted.** Submit two (2) copies of your bid in a sealed envelope or similar package marked “**EXTEND FIRE TRUCK BAY AT FIRE STATION 20**” on the front of the envelope.

Bids will be opened and respondents announced at 3:00 P.M. local time, or as soon thereafter as practical, on October 12, 2017, in the Baker County Administrative offices, 55 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Macclenny FL 32063. The bid opening is open to the public.
