JOB OVERVIEW

This is heavy manual work of a routine and unskilled nature. Employee in this position is responsible for the satisfactory performance of heavy manual laboring tasks in road construction and maintenance. Work is performed under immediate supervision of a Leaderman. Most tasks are routine, repetitive in nature and learned with little difficulty.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

High school graduate or completion of GED. Valid Florida Driver's License.
